American Rescue Plan Act

- Passed in March 2021 to 'deliver immediate and direct relief to families and workers' and 'build a bridge to an equitable economic recovery'
- \$350 Billion dedicated to State, local and Tribal territories
 - \$161,395,498 allotment for Montgomery County
 - \$80,697,749 on-hand. Second installment due in 2022
 - Obligated by December 31, 2024
 - Expended by December 31, 2026
- Act provides direct funding to schools and municipalities



Local Fiscal Recovery Funds Eligible Uses

- Support public health expenditures
- Address negative economic impacts caused by the public health emergency
- Serving the hardest-hit communities and families
- Replace lost public sector revenue
- Provide premium pay for essential workers
- Invest in water, sewer, and broadband infrastructure
