## Self-Determination Housing of Pennsylvania,

a program of **Inglis Community Services**, announces

**Inglis Home Modifications for Independence (HMI)**. HMI helps homeowners over the age of 65 remain independent by staying in their homes through **free** home modifications rather than losing independence and needing to relocate to a more accessible environment, such as a nursing care facility.

Additionally, the HMI program also supports home modifications for people with disabilities. The program is funded, in part, by a grant from the Department of Housing and Urban Development through their Older Adult's Home Modification Program.

### Home Modification Examples

- Grab bars/railings, tub/shower transfer bench
- Access ramps
- Motorized chair lift
- Raised toilet seat/supports

### Program Eligibility Requirements

- 65 years of age or older
- Own your home
- Meet income requirements
- Other eligibility criteria may apply
