SERVICES

The Dental Hygiene Clinic at Montgomery County Community College offers a wide array of preventative and oral health services for adults and children. All patients receive a medical/dental history exam, oral cancer screening, periodontal and restorative charting and x-rays. This information is used to develop an individualized treatment plan that may include any of the following:

- Risk assessments
- Prophylaxis (cleaning)
- Non-surgical periodontal therapy (scaling & root planing)
- Patient education & oral hygiene instructions
- Dental sealants
- Nutritional Counseling
- Tobacco Cessation Counseling
- Intraoral photographs
- Impressions & Study Models
- Fluoride treatment
- Comprehensive referrals for continued care

The Clinic does not provide restoration dental care, fillings, dentures, root canals, or extractions.

SCHEDULING

The clinic operates September-May and schedules vary by semester. Call 215-641-6483 to request an appointment.

Appointments are based upon student availability. Please plan on a minimum of 3.5 hours per appointment. More than one visit will be required for comprehensive care.

PATIENT RIGHTS

Patients have a right to:

- Considerate, respectful and confidential treatment
- Continuity and completion of treatment
- Access to complete and current information about his/her condition
- Advance knowledge of the cost of treatment
- Informed consent
- Explanation of recommendations, alternatives, expected outcomes, and risks of refusing treatment
- Treatment that meets the standard of care in the profession
